Our new Look- We have been hard at work coming up with a new look for the Village. We have designed a new log that you will be seeing more and more as we replace signs and add it to items to be sold at the pool. To go along with our new logo, the website has also gotten a facelift and be updated on a regular basis. If you have not signed up on the website, please do so today. Pool – So good news, we installed a brand new pump! I know not very exciting, but we had two older pumps, one was shot and the other was on its last legs. They were so old that finding replacement parts over the years became very difficult and not money well spent. Our brand shinny new pump is a 15 hp motor which replaced two older motors; it is more energy efficient & runs much quieter. The entire pool area has a fresh coat of paint, which really brightens up the place and we are adding some additional landscaping to give it a more finished look. We are still exploring purchasing shade canopies for the pool deck, but as we were not expecting to replace the pool motors this year, we want to make sure the budget can handle the added expenditure before we move forward.

Swim Team-The Preston Village Tiger Sharks are off to another great summer. With over 80 swimmers on the team, we are even larger than last year. Kids are becoming stronger swimmers, parents are getting to know other neighbors in the community and we are all having so much fun! As the neighborhood ages some of our trees are dying or becoming over grown. Gloomy scale has gotten to many of our maple trees and they will likey die from it. are regularly out and about, bringing these things to the attention of the landscaper, it would ensure the beauty of Preston Village for years to come.
